Program description

Certified professional coders (CPCs) are an important component of the medical billing process and the health care team. The CPC reviews clinical statements and assigns standard codes using CPT®, ICD-10-CM and HCPCS Level II classification systems so that medical claims can be submitted for reimbursement.
