The central idea behind LSS is that if an organization can measure how many "defects" there can be in a process, then it can easily and systematically identify ways to eliminate them with the aim of reaching as close to zero defects as possible.

Other important information

- Our Lean Six Sigma courses are a combination of self-paced online learning and classroom-based learning led by an instructor at one of our campus locations.
- Our comprehensive courses include material from Yellow Belt through Green Belt.
- Participants must complete all assigned course modules with an 80% or better and utilize project coaching hours (when applicable) within 30 days after the last classroom session. Successful exam and project completion must occur within 60 days of the last classroom session.
