Career-Technical Transfer Assurance Guides (CTAGs/CT2)

Collaboration among the Ohio Department of Higher Education, the Ohio Department of Education and other key stakeholders led to the development of policies and procedures to create statewide careertechnical discipline-specific articulation agreements. This collaboration further ensures that students completing coursework at an adult or high school career-technical institution can articulate and transfer agreedupon technical courses/programs to any Ohio public institution of higher education "without unnecessary duplication or institutional barriers." Career-Technical Assurance Guides (CTAGs) are statewide articulation agreements that make sure learning at public high schools and adult career-technical institutions is recognized. They offer the opportunity for the award of college credit toward technical courses/programs at any public higher education institution. CTAGs serve as advising tools, identifying the statewide content guarantee and describing other conditions or obligations (e.g., program accreditation or an industry credential) associated with the guarantee. To be awarded CTAG credit at Tri-C, students must confirm that the College offers a degree program in their career-technical field. Learn more about CTAG credit and the processing instructions.

Career-Technical Articulation Number (CTAN)

A CTAN consists of learning outcomes representing knowledge and skills in a technical area that are needed to transition from Ohio public careertechnical education to an Ohio public institution of higher education. Learning outcomes are based on recognized industry standards in the technical area and are established by faculty panels comprised of subject-area experts from across Ohio's public institutions of higher education.
