Program Description

This 120-hour course gives students the skills and knowledge required to obtain a Class B CDL driver's license. Training includes pre-trip vehicle inspection, vehicle control and on-road driving (required for skills testing).

This program is licensed by the Ohio Department of Public Safety as a CDL Driver Training School.

This program meets all federal ELDT requirements.

Course outline

- Minimum of 40 hours of classroom instruction
- Minimum of 8 hours on skills pad (maneuverability)
- Minimum of 8 hours of behind-the-wheel road training
- Additional minimum of 12 hours of behind-the-wheel maneuverability and road skills
- Combined 52 hours spent observing skills and practicing pre-trip inspection

Other Important Information

Admission requirements

- At least 18 years old
- Valid Ohio driver's license
- High school diploma or GED diploma (or required test score in basic math, reading and comprehension)
- Pass the DOT physical and drug screen
- Pass the basic permit test

Program Cost

\$4,500, plus a nonrefundable \$200 administrative fee

Includes:

- CDL learner's permit
- DOT physical and drug screen
- Classroom materials
- CDL state test
- CDL license upon successful CDL exam completion

Financial aid eligibility

This program is **not** Federal Financial Aid/Pell-Eligible.
