Other content

Participants must meet the following criteria in order to take the PMP exam through the Project Management Institute (PMI).

- Secondary degree (high school diploma, associate degree or global equivalent)
- 60 months of project management experience
- 35 hours of project management experience or CAPM certification

OR

- Four-year degree
- 36 months of project management experience within last 8 years
- 35 hours of project management education or CAPM certification
